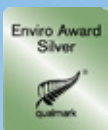
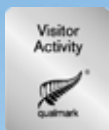

Massive engines roar as the iconic “Big Yellow” KJet boat tears out of beautiful Queenstown Bay across the pristine waters of Lake Wakatipu and towards an unforgettable experience along two of New Zealand’s most scenic and action-packed rivers the Shotover and Kawarau.

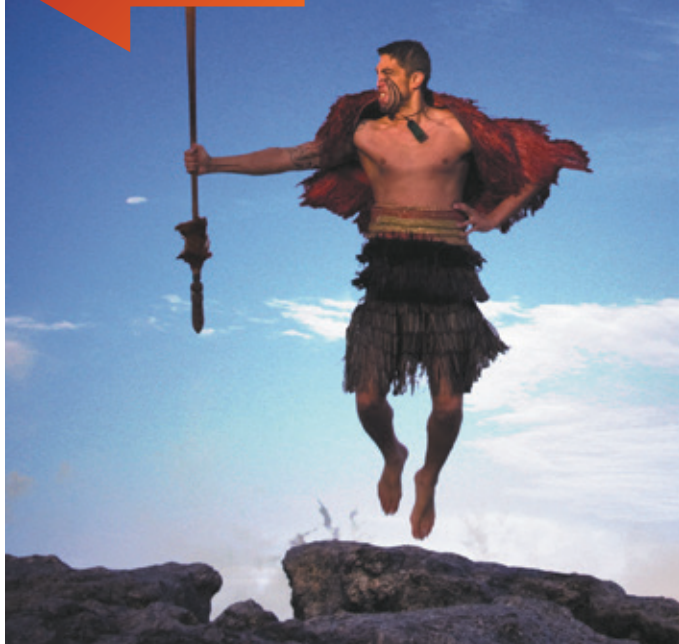
